

# Women stars appear at festival

A Women's Jazz Festival featuring some of the leading women jazz artists in the United States will be one of the highlights of the Festival of Wheels, to be held May 11-13 in Dearborn.

Among the women jazz talents expected to perform at the festival are Mary Lou Williams, Joanne Brackeen, Betty Bonner, Dorothy Ashby, Lenore Paxton and Terri Lynne Carrington, a 13-year-old drummer who has played with Oscar Peterson and Buddy Rich. Portland is acting as consultant. The performances are scheduled for two nights of the Festival of Wheels, at 8:30 p.m. on both Friday and Saturday. The performances will be held outdoors under a tent near the Hyatt Regency. Tickets are \$7.

The jazz joins a list of other events scheduled for the three-day festival, which is billed as honoring man's greatest invention — the wheel.

A shuttle bus will operate between the five festival sites.

The Anheuser-Busch Clydesdale horse team will make its first visit to the Detroit area as part of the festival. The horses will appear at spots throughout Dearborn over the three days.

Other highlights of the festival are:

- A parade, 7 p.m. Friday on Michigan Avenue.
- National Antique Car Meet, sponsored by the Veteran Motor Car Club of America, Saturday at Greenfield Village.
- An auto show at the Hyatt's exhibit center, 11 a.m. to 11 p.m. Friday-Saturday and 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Sunday.
- A disco dance contest, 9 p.m. Friday in the Dearborn Civic Center, Greenfield at Michigan.

There will also be carnival rides, helicopter rides, a pie eating contest and other standard festival fare.
