

Square Lake grabs tennis lead

The Square Lake Racquet Club of Bloomfield Hills took first place in the Team-One Division of the Suburban Tennis League by defeating the Court House Tennis and Racquet Club of West Bloomfield 240-111 last week.

Square Lake currently has 3,103 points.

Square Lake lost only four of the 24 matches thanks to strong women's singles play. The women did not lose a match, while the men lost only two singles matches.

Highlight matches that day saw Bob Kinley (Court House) and Paul Felix (Square Lake) battle for more than two hours before Kinley won 11-10. He fought back from a 5-0 deficit in the second set.

Another match between Jim Hayes (Square Lake) and Mike Vranich (Court House) wasn't decided until Hayes won a tiebreaker 5-3.

Bobbie Daniels (Square Lake) plays the number-one position in women's singles and has a 12-1 record.

Franklin Racquet Club of Southfield finished its season with 3,081 points after defeating Deer Lake Racquet Club of Clarkston 238-164. Franklin currently holds second place in the standings. The Franklin men won all eight singles

matches and the women lost only two. Byron Bez (Franklin) lost only one match during the regular season, compiling an 11-1 record. Ed Barter (Franklin), who is also a championship-level racquetball player, finished with a 9-1 record.

Centaur Racquet Club of West Bloomfield has a chance to overtake Franklin for second place and a spot in the post-season playoffs against Square Lake, however. Centaur needs 200 points in tomorrow's match against Rochester Hills Racquet Club to move ahead of Franklin.

The playoffs will be held Sunday. Beverly Hills Racquet Club finished in first place in the Team Two Division after defeating Farmington Racquet Club 136-123 in its final match of the season. Beverly Hills finished with a total of 1,634 points. Farmington placed second with 1,567 and Centaur dropped to third place with 1,562 points.

Deer Lake Racquet Club defeated Franklin 159-108 to end its season.

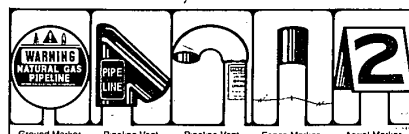

A trained operator will obtain information on location and type of work. "Miss Dig" will then notify any utility with facilities in the area. Participating utilities, including Panhandle Eastern Pipe Line Company, will send representatives to identify any underground installations.

"Miss Dig" can help you avoid a dangerous situation. Pipeline markers locate the buried pipeline only in the immediate vicinity of the marker. Any type of ditching, boring, drilling, blasting, deep plowing, excavating, earth moving, mining or seismic work in the vicinity of a pipeline is potentially dangerous. That is why it is important to seek help 48 hours before you undertake any of these activities near a pipeline.
