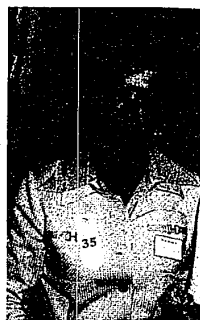


## *We all should ponder Salt II*

Patricia Cody of Bloomfield Hills recently was cited for 35 years of volunteer service with the American Red Cross. Her commendation came at a volunteer and staff recognition ceremony.

About 650 women are expected to assemble for this three-day program to concentrate on career and self development. The workshops will include such areas as managing stress, strategies to develop management skills, non-traditional jobs, financial planning, decision making and time management.

While 21 percent of the postal work force is comprised of women, they hold only 11 percent of the management positions level 15 and above. The conference is primarily to assist women in being aware of the available positions and offer informational assistance on how to go about getting them.

Dialysis may be necessary every 24 to 30 hours for the children. They will be at camp during regular summer sessions, beginning June 25 and ending August 19.

Storer Camps are located on Stony Lake near Napoleon in the Irish Hills. The camps on the north and south sides of the lake and their adjoining areas comprise 1,000 acres.

"What To Do With Your Leisure Time" is the subject of a lecture planned at 8 p.m. Thursday, June 14, by the Widowed-to-Widowed Committee of SPACE, a service of the Greater Detroit Section, National Council of Jewish Women.

The program will take place in the NCJW office, 16400 W. Twelve Mile, Southfield.

Representatives of several community groups will explore a variety of social and recreational activities. A member of the American Youth Hostel will be on hand to discuss its program.

The AYH organizes recreational and sports activities for groups, schedules specific events, and suggests appropriate training programs.

Also included is a representative of the Sunday Jewish Singles, a social organization sponsored by the Jewish Community Center.

The evening is the first of a summer lecture series planned by the Widowed-to-Widowed group. Future programs will take place on July 12 and Aug. 9. Refreshments are served following the meetings. Admission is \$1.
