Friend of court often unknown

Michigan residents have a "friend indeed" who has been around for 60 years but is unknown to many. This friend is not a person but a legal system meant to enforce child supopt after a divorce judgment. The "friend of the court" investigates all divorce; paternity and family support cases in-volving minor children. After its investigation the friend of

After its investigation, the friend of the court submits recommendations to the court about child custody, visitation and amounts of child support and ali-mony.

Tonik Kennedy, executive editor at the Institute for Social Research at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, replained the system at a recent meet-ing of the Northwest Wayne County chapter of the National Organization or Wormen. "The friend of the court has poten-tial," she told 20 women. "It can do some great work, but also can cre-ate some big problems. "People have to be informed (about this) because we all have to be involved in policy decisions that are made." She said the system is useful, hut

In policy decisions that are made." She said the system is useful, but should be reorganized because "It's pretty much a bureaucratic mess." The friend of the court can be useful even if the parties involved don't have a major disagreement, Ms. Kennedy said.

a major disagreement, Ms. Kennedy said. "It is not necessarily a waste of time when there appears to be an agree-ment," she said. "One party may be pressured by all kinds of situations. Someone-looking over the agreement issures that i just ian't passed over." She said that areas in the system needing reorganization include its re-view function and the way in which its specific policies and procedures are cetermined.

The friend of the court is required by law to review any child support orders every two years if the child is on wel-fare, when ever it has information about new conditions that may justify modification, or on request from the custodial parent, but not more than every two years.

trict, outcome inters it will follow. These are different in each county. "There is disagreement among coun-ties about what the statutes tell them to do," Ms. Kennedy said. "No one can interpret the statutes." The real question of reorganization is how it can be paid for, she said. "Any kind of reorganization has al-ways got to deal with this big question: "Where is the money coming from?" she said.

Where is the money coming from?" she said. Michigan had the best record in the country for collecting court ordered child support cases in 1974, when 65 percent of all such cases were collect-ed.

"But 65 parcent is not really very good," she said. She said that Gennes-see county collected 82 percent of cas-es that year, when it happened to have high unemployment. The Michigan friend of the court sys-tem, established in 1919, is the only one in the United States. Other states use a family court system or specialized courts that deal with domstic matters. These are not very successful, Ms. Ken-nedy said, be cause they tend to be courts of lesser stature.
