Water quality board chairman appointed

Waterford Township Supervisor James E. Secterlin is the first chairperson of the areawide water quality board, the waterholog agency for water pollution control programs in south-east Michigan.

The 27-member board also elected Richard A. Rudnicki, Livingston County drain commissioner, and Peggy Johnson, executive secretary of the Clinton River watershed council, to serve as vice chairpersons.

The board is composed of elected officials and business, education, conservation and technical representatives from Wegnes, Oakland, Macomb, Washtenaw, Monroe, Livingston and St. Clair counties. It was created to monitor the implementation of a comprehensive water quality management plan developed by the Southeat Michigan Council of Government (SEMCOG).

Along with other tasks, the board is responsible for monitoring the construction schedules of wastewater treatment facilities and the implementation of programs to control non-point (from lands and streets) sources of water pollution.
