## Woman takes a fatal plunge off of bridge

The body of a 54-year-old Farmington Hills woman was recovered from the Detroit River Saturday afternoon after she jumped from the Ambassador Bridge.

U.S. Coast Guard personnel recovered the body of Nancy Huff one mile west of the bridge (near the Detroit Marine Terminal) and 120 feet south of the international border just before 1 p.m.

The body was turned over to Canadian officials.

According to Windsor Police Inspector Alec Somerville, the woman, a Chrysler Corporation office worker,

left her 1978 Plymouth Volari with the motor running parked along the west curb of the bridge on the Canadian side. A pair of sunglasses was found on the sidewalk near the car.

She jumped at 12:35 p.m. The plunge was witnessed by two Hamtramck residents in a boat on the river. Their attempts to find the body were unsuccessful, but they notified police.

Detroit Police Harbor Patrol on Belle Isle responded to the scene but were not involved because the incident occurred in Canada.

The body was taken to Grace Hospital in Windsor.
