The equipment Orr needed to predict the weather was expensive and neither college student had much money. They rented some pieces of equipment and arranged for a loan to buy the rest.

Orr's situation brightened when the ownership of Houghton radio station WHDF changed hands in April. Soon after, he was hired to forceast weather for the new station, called WCCY.

Orr and Davis still had problems collecting enough revenue to meet expenses. Davis became discouraged and left the business; Orr continued his venture solo for a while.

"I REALLY ENJOY being right in my forecasts," he said. "I think I'm wrong one day out of every two weeks. It's even more fun when my competi-tion runs a different forecast and it turns out wrong."

Orr's last day of Copper Country precasts was June 30.

Now he doesn't have to worry about nding clients and he's paid a regular
