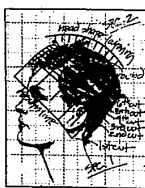

Photographer documents Pope John Paul II's election

The photographs do the speaking in "From a Distant Country," a pictorial record by area photographer Tony Spina focusing on Pope John Paul II's election to the papacy.

The camera eye of Spina, crisply records the changes in the papacy that both stunned and surprised the world last autumn in a 32-page, soft bound book.

"From a Distant Country," Spina's third book on the papacy, retails for \$3.95 and is available at all Hudson's book shops.

The photo book starts with the funeral of Pope Paul VI, moves to the election of Pope John Paul I, the mourning that followed his 33-day reign, and the surprise election of Karol Cardinal Wojtyla, the Roman Catholic Church's first Polish Pope.

Spina's dramatic black and white photographs — 47 in all — capture the magnitude of the events and the grandeur of the Vatican. Text is limited to captions and a chronology of the events.

ESPECIALLY CAPTIVATING is a four-photo series of then Cardinal Wojtyla, who scoffs at the possibility of becoming Pope during a brief curb-side interview with Spina.

The book contains several other unusual photos. One is a procession of cardinals at the funeral of Pope Paul VI that shows Cardinal Albino Luciani, who days later became Pope John Paul I. Cardinal Wojtyla succeeded him as Pontiff.

The second is one of the last known photographs of Pope John Paul II as a cardinal. Spina's camera captures a thoughtful Cardinal Wojtyla as he marches with other cardinals toward the isolation of the secret conclave at which he was elected.

Another is a whimsical shot of a nun and another woman perched on the communion rail at one of St. Peter's side altars, patiently waiting for news from the conclave.

The title, "From a Distant Country," is taken from John Paul II's first public words as Pope. "And now the eminent cardinals have called for a new bishop of Rome," he told the crowd cheering the announcement of his election Oct.

16, 1978. "They have called him from a distant country, distant but so close through the communion in the Christian faith and tradition."

Spina, who covered the Pope's recent trip to Poland, has an international reputation. His work has been featured in more than 30 one-man shows, including one at the Vatican and one at the Hermitage in Leningrad, Russia.

A NATIVE OF DETROIT, Spina has been closely linked with the papacy for more than 20 years, starting with the election of Pope John XXIII, and his first book, "The Making of the Pope."

Spina, who was named a Knight of

St. Gregory by Pope John XXIII, also is the author of "The Pope and the Council," which centered around Pope John and Pope Paul VI and their roles at the Second Vatican Council.

He also produced a photo book on John F. Kennedy's presidency, "This Was the Presidency," and a book of newspapering, "Press Photographer." Spina and his family live in Bloomfield Hills.

"From a Distant Country" is a complete production. The publisher is McPaul/Crandall, Inc., and it was printed by Century Litho, Inc., both Detroit firms.
