Grant to fund pilot water study

The Southeast Michigan Council of Governments (SEMCOG) has been awarded a \$170.000 domonstration grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EFA) to find more cost-effective ways to control water pollution caused when stormater sys-tems carry debris dust, et all litter, oil and grease, decomposal every and grass and toxic materials into streams and takes.

The grant, effective July 6, was awarded under the EPA's nationwide urban runoff program and is for the first year of a proposed three-year program. The total project cost is an estimated sans ann

gram. The total project cost is an esti-mated \$565,000.

SEMCOG will administer the grant in cooperation with the Oakland county Drain Commission.

SEMCOG selected Oakland County for the test project because it has im-plemented stormwater and sedimenta-


