**Contest hopefuls set  
for Farmington pageant**

One of the highlights of the Farmington Founder's Festival — the Miss Farmington Scholarship Festival — will be held at Vladimir's on Wednesday, July 26.

Competing for the title of Miss Farmington 1979 will be 10 young women, with the winner advancing to the Miss Michigan Pageant.

WDRQ-FM disc jockey Jim Clark will host the 6th Annual Farmington pageant, which traditionally opens the festival. Musical entertainment will be provided by the Dan Yessian Arrangement.

The 10 girls vying for the crown will be judged by a panel in four different categories: talent (50 percent of the point total); swim suit (16 1/2 percent); on-stage personality (16 1/2 percent); and judge's interviews (16 1/2 percent).

The judge's interviews will be held on the afternoon prior to the pageant, with points awarded for personality, mental alertness, sincerity, general knowledge and intelligence.

The girl who accumulates the most points will be crowned Miss Farmington and receive a \$1000 scholarship and \$350 to spend on a wardrobe for the Miss Michigan pageant.

use towards her education, and the second runner-up receives \$50 to use for scholastic endeavors. An additional prize of \$25 will be awarded to the winner of the talent segment.

The Miss Farmington pageant is a franchise of the Miss Michigan and Miss America pageants. Holly Ann Schmidt, who won the Farmington title in 1976, went on to capture the Miss Michigan crown as well and competed in the Miss America pageant.

Last year's Miss Farmington, Pamela Prichard, finished as first runner-up in the Miss Michigan competition this year. She will turn her crown over to this year's winner.

This year's Miss Farmington will make her first official appearance after the pageant at 9:30 p.m. in the Downtown Center. The Franklin Band will perform in her honor.

Tickets are now on sale at the Farmington Chamber of Commerce office, 23715 Farmington Road. The cost is \$3 in advance and \$4 at the door, with all seating reserved. The pageant will start at 7 p.m. at Vladimir's, Grand River west of Eight Mile Road.
