## Lace exhibit now on display

The Plymouth Historical Museum's summer exhibit is on the many kinds of lace and the history of lace-making, which can be traced from primitive man's experimentation with knotting to fine needlepoint and bobbin laces centuries later.

On display are on Irish blouse, jabots which were worn in the early 1900s, and a fashion show of lace dresses from

the 1800s to the 1940s.

The museum is located at 155 S. Main and is open Thursday, Saturday and Sunday from 1-4 p.m.

Admission is \$1 for adults; 50 cents for youth; and 25 cents for those from 5-11 years.
