OIL SPRAY SOLVES PROBLEM

Shifting Sand Dunes Form Serious Obstacle to Improved Road Making in Northwest.

Shifting sand dunes which cover up a highway soon after it is completed have formed a serious obtained to improved road building in some parts of the country, particularly in the Northwest. To 'remedy the evil, the bureau of public roads of the United States Department of Agricul-United States Department of Agriculture has employed a more extensive application of the agency that has been used in the past to last on ordinary highways—oil.
