LAYING OUT FLOWER GARDEN

Even With Small Space, Much Can Accomplished in Making Effactive Home Surroundings.

With a long narrow lot there is not much choice in the arrangement of borders and beds, but the effect will be more pleasing it the center is left in the grass, and have flower borders along the sides, while at the far end there might be a border of indeering shrubs, the shrubs suring in the correst of the side borders and running across the end of the lot, the shrub border beling widest in the middle. 

Figures Concerning the Weight of Crowds.
