

CHECKING UP ON WHEEL ALIGNMENT



Checking up on the wheel alignment of it car is not hard to accomplish it the car owner will take the time to do it. The front and rear wheels on one side of the car should be put straight in blue so that a string, as shown in the illustration, will come in contact with the tires at the front and the rear of each. Having thred the wheels on this side, a string should be carried to the other side of the car where the process is repeated. Should a distance of more than a quarter inch be found to exits between the side of the tire and the string, the wheel is out of alignment. The greater this distance the greater the wear on the tread. Having discovered this, the wheel should be properly adjusted.

UNIVERSAL JOINT IS VITAL PART OF AUTO

Portion of Car Works So Hard and Efficiently.

Power of Engine and Transmits to Propeller Shaft Which Moves According to Move-ment of Rear Axle.

There are hundreds of moving parts There are hundreds of moving parts on an automobile or motortruck, but none works so hard and so efficiently as a universal joint. The universal joint, as its name indicates, allows for free or universal movement of the propeller shaft. It is like your thumb, which you can wiggle in all directions.

A universal joint takes the power of the engine and transmits it to the propeller shaft. At the same time this joint may be constantly moving first in fine direction, then another, but usually it moves up and down because the rear aske keeps moving up and down over the road.

The propeller shaft angularity varies according to the relative movement of the rear wate, and were it not for the use of universal joints the shaft would hend or break, and heave could not transmit power.

an all-metal joint, and the only care
which this hard-working part receives
is a little grease twice each year. It is




