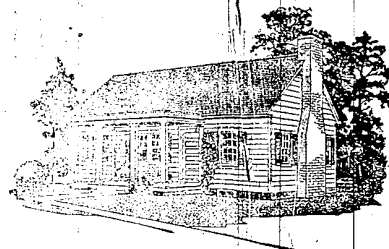

"Sabbath day's Journey."
A "Sabbath day's journey" was the distance that the law of the Jews (eventually also of the early Christians) permitted one to walk on Sunday. In Acts 1:12 the Sabbath day's journey is placed at the distance of Mount Olivet, from Jerusalem. Anyone could walk the distance from the city around the suburbs, and by the rule of the Levites this distance was fixed at a circumference the radius of which was 2,000 cubits. The Talmud places the Sabbath day's journey at 12 miles.
