Most Legion posts don't have a sufficient number of honor guard teams set up to handle all the requests for military funerals, McKenna said-tie hopes one result of his struggle to fulfill his mother's wish for a military funeral will be considered to the form of the rites.

#### County Gets \$311,093 For Roads

Oakland County will receive \$311,093 out of the state's share of a federal highway grant according to an announcement from the State Highway Commission.

The Michigan counties and the Department of State High-ways have been allotted nearly \$10.7 million in Federal Aid Society highway money for the fiscal year.

This amount is \$70,000 less than was received during the current fiscal year. The reason for the reduction is the fact that the increase in Michigan's county road mileage was not as great as the increase in the national average.
