The king crab, formerly only found
in merchantable quantities near Japan,
has invaded the waters of Cook linke,
Prince William sound, off Sitka, and
Bering sea, in such numbers that four
canneries in Alaska are-packing the
glant shellfish, says a Seattle correspondent. About 20,000 cases is the
expected output, worth SS5 a case, or
\$700,000.
