

One-session clinic aims to break the smoking habit

A Farmington business woman who couldn't get to a non-smoking clinic in Northville last month has arranged for

the clinic to come to her.
"When I read about Barry Beder's method of breaking the smoking habit, I knew that if I was ever going to do it,

that was the way I was going to do it," said Glenda Ray of Ray Interiors. Beder's method is hypnosis, completed in a one-session 90-minute program incorporating five techniques recommended by U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare, the National Institute of Health and the National Cancer Institute.

Mrs. Ray will open the doors of Ray Interiors at 7:30 p.m. Wednesday, March 5, for the clinic she's bringing to Farmington. The store is located at 33300 Slocum, east of Farmington Road, south of Grand River.

Both Beder and Mrs. Ray are taking a gamble as to how many corners they will have turned out to the clinic. She is underwriting his minimum charge. In turn, Beder is giving a reduction from his usual \$45-per-person charge, to \$30 per person.

By concentrating on emotional change, the transition through hypnosis from smoker to non-smoker is achieved without nervous tension and without weight gain.


