

Segula takes state wrestling championship

It couldn't have been better for John Segula of Bloomfield Hills Laker. The tough 116-pounder completed a perfect 42-0 wrestling season Saturday, winning three matches en route to the state title in state meet competition at Lansing Eastern.

For the senior Segula, who is the first Class A state champion from southern Oakland County in many, many years, it was a satisfying end to a long, illustrious career at Lahser.

"Despite his early-season victories which weren't all that impressive, Segula, who finished sixth in the state meet as a junior, got stronger and stronger as his senior season progressed before reaching his ultimate goal as state champion. It was later revealed that Segula was recovering all season from an operation, causing his slow start.

"But we new inside that he could put things together," said Lahser coach Al Kehl. Segula pinned North Farmington's John Donavan at 1:20 for the crown. His most impressive match, however, was a 12-4 decision over highly-regarded Jeff Brown from Plymouth Salem in the semifinals. The Lahser matman was defeated Mike Andrews of Kalamazoo in an opening-round match, 12-1.

Segula, who is being heavily recruited by state colleges, finished with a 114-12 career record. As a team, Lahser was the top southern Oakland County finisher — placing ninth with 47 points. Davison won the Class A title. Perennial power Temperance-Bedford was second.

Joy LeVier, wrestling at 136, placed a surprising second for the Knights to help that team total. Teammate Steve Sugayan (130) was qualified for the state meet but lost his first two matches at 130.

BIRMINGHAM GROVES qualified two wrestlers for the state meet. Matt Kennedy (171) lost his first match 6-9, and had to forfeit his second match because of a back injury. Tom Maroudis (159) also qualified for the Falcons but

couldn't compete because of an ear injury.

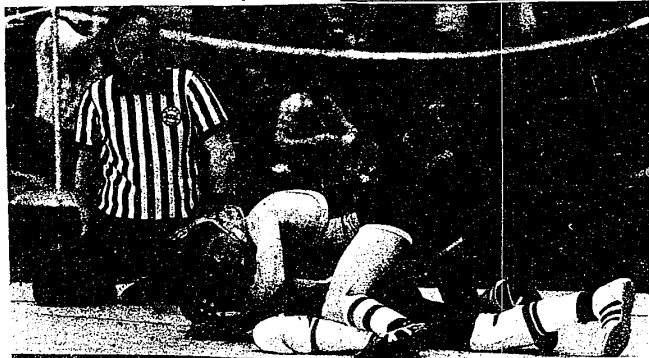

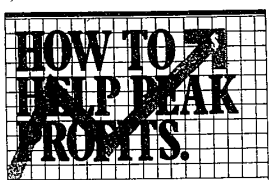

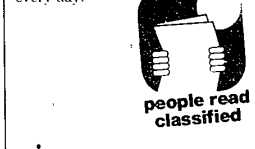
