Steelhead are running

Spring steelhead season is about to begin on southern Michigan rivers.

Best results on the Huron River from Lake Erie to Flat Rock will begin any day and run through mid-April, according to the Automobile Club of Michigan.

Ron Spitter, state Department of Natural Resources fish biologist, said last fall's steelhead fishing was "very good."

"Our plant of 20,000 fish here in 1978 paid off. Increased flow rate in the river all fall from the Belleville Lake drawdown is believed to have improved the run.

But Spitler added that "problems of trespass on city of Flat Rock property near the dam by non-residents continued to plague fishermen from the metro area. These problems are being resolved in

court."
The St. Clair River steelhead run should be from late April to early June, said Auto Club.
Spitler added, 'The spring coho fishery on the St. Clair River has been eliminated with the decision to greatly reduce plants of these fish in Lake Huron. However, an excellent chinook fishery has

"One local charter fisherman at Algonac reported boating about 400 chinook from mid-April through mid-May ranging in size from 1-18 pounds. Very few steelhead, brown trout or other salmonids were taken, however.

Michigar's mild winter may mean an early spring bonanza for steelhead anglers, said Auto Club.

Water temperatures in the 40s will trigger the spawning urge in more than one million 10-15 pound laker untrout in 34 rivers. Twin reasons: Warmer water from less spring snow melt will send fish up the streams a week to 10 days earlier than usual and result in excellent wading conditions.
