The Helsinki Academic Glee Club, sometimes known as "The Singing Finns," steps for three concert appearances in the Detroit metropolitan area during its spring tour in the U.S.

The glee club performs with the Scandinavian Symphony at 8:20 p.m. Saturday, March 22, in Southfield's new

Civic Auditorium, 26000 Evergreen. The orchestra is under the direction of Valter Poole. Tickets are available at the door.

At 4:30 p.m. Sunday, March 23, the Helsinki Academic Glee Club members will be guests of honor at a reception given for them in Finnish Cultural Cen-

ter, 35200 Eight Mile Rd. The club will perform during the afternoon.

At 8 p.m. Monday, March 24, the club moves to Christ Church Cranbrook for a special concert in tribute to the Saarinen family, both architects and artists at Cranbrook Institute. Tickets will be available at the door.

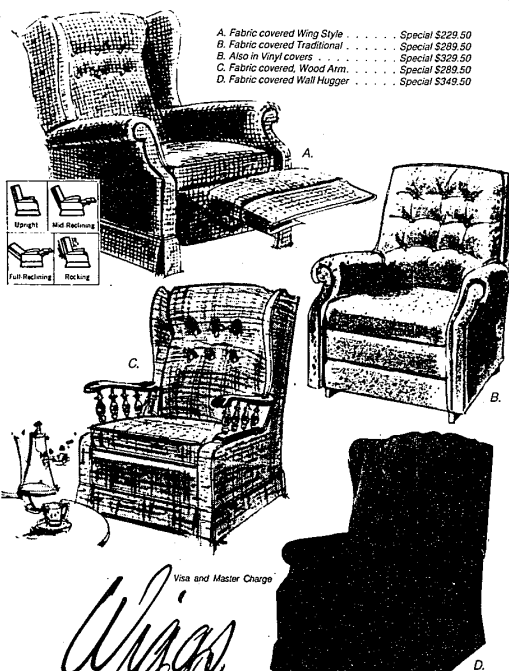
