

Libraries spring with new agenda of programs

Children of all ages are invited to enjoy a variety of programs with a new twist at the Farmington Community Library. "The Best of Library LIVE" will be presented through various registration-required programs.

It all begins during spring vacation with a "Yo-Yo Vacation Special" for grades one through six. Don LaPlant of Duncan Toys will give a special presentation on yo-yo history, tricks and techniques. Bring your yo-yo and join in on the fun at 11 a.m. April 7 in the Farmington library on Liberty, or at 1 p.m. the same day at the Farmington Hills library on 12 Mile.

For National Library Week, the library offers two special programs. Preschoolers, kindergartners and their parents are invited to "A Pet Show" where a show and tell with prizes will be featured. If your pet knows any tricks, now's the time to

show off. Bring your pet on a leash, in a cage, or in a container. This event will be conducted outside, weather permitting. In case of inclement weather, the event will be rescheduled.

The Farmington branch's pet show is from 2 to 2:30 p.m. April 17. Alternate day, in case of poor weather, is 10:30 to 11 a.m. April 18. The Farmington Hills branch will have its pet show from 2 to 2:30 p.m. April 15. Alternate day is 11:30 to 12 p.m. April 17.

FOR THE pet shows, registration is required by calling the Farmington branch at 474-7770 or the Hills branch at 553-0300. Registration begins April 4.

Grades one through six are invited to the first "Library Olympics" for National Library Week from 10:30 to 11:30 a.m. April 19 at the Farmington branch or from 2 to 3 p.m. at the Hills

branch. Tickets will be given out at the door for each event. No registration is necessary. Games include: "Super Skills: Ring the Bells," "Zan Boomer's Nerf Basketball," "Lentil's Cracker-then" and "Flintstones Bowl-A-Bottle." Special prizes will be awarded to winners. An Olympic thirst quencher will be served to all participants.

Many other programs offered for children during April and May will require telephone registration, beginning March 28. Farmington and Farmington Hills residents will be given first preference. Children may sign up for as many programs as they'd like on a first come, first serve basis.

Programs for preschoolers and kindergarten

at the Farmington branch will begin with "April Showers - May Flowers" from 10:30 to 11 a.m. April 11. Movies and a flower craft will be presented with parents encouraged to attend.

"The Beat Goes On," a music experience for children 4 and 5 years old will be from 10:30 to 11 a.m. April 15. Other preschool/Kindergarten programs include: "In a Spring Garden" storyhour from 10:30 to 11 a.m. May 1; "Big Bird's Bash" from 2 to 2:30 p.m. April 22 and "Our Feathered Friends" for all preschoolers and parents at 10:30 a.m. May 9.

For first- and second-graders, three programs will be presented. "Monster Mash" is from 4 to 5 p.m. April 14. Stories

and crafts will be involved in "Around the World Adventure" from 4 to 5 p.m. April 23. Then "Dinosaur Days" will be from 4 to 5 p.m. April 29.

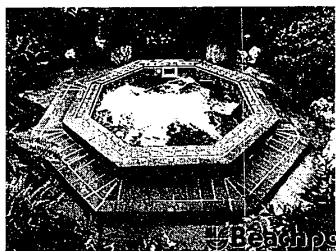

"A Rainbow of Story Treasures" will be shown on April 29 and "Slithering Snakes" will slide across the screen from 2 to 2:30 p.m. May 1.

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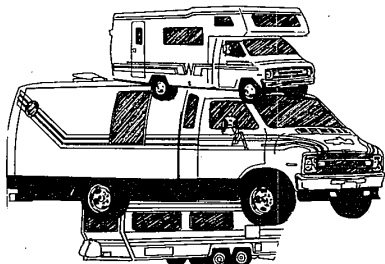
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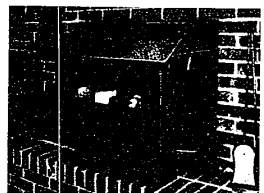
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
