Y lines up trips for 1980

While the Farmington Area YMCA staff completes its new facility in April, it simultaneously launches its new program of trips.

New program director David Seefeld proposes several new ideas for the year from a 14 year background in camping, canoeing and touring.

"My plans are to begin with a few of the old favorites," Seefeld said, "then add my own touch with visits to several new spots, such as whitewater canoeing in western Wisconsin, a trip to the White Mountain in New Hampshire, and some white water rafting in West Virginia and Pennsylvania."

The year's program begins with a ten day trip to Georgia down the Appalachian Trail along with a day of rafting

on the Nanantahala River in North Carolina. The trip, which runs from April 4-13 is open to all persons from seventh grade and up.

The summer program begins in June with a trip which combines rafting on the New River and Youghiogheny River in West Virginia and Pennsylvania and some hiking through the Shenandoah Mountains in Virginia.

This will be followed with the offering of a week long canoe trip up the Flambeau River in Wisconsin. "The river is rated the best in that state," Seefeld said.

MORE HIGHLIGHTS on the summer agenda are visits to Lake Placid and the Adirondack Mountains; hiking

along the Burr Trail in Ontario, Canada and the Appalachian Trail in North Carolina.

The summer winds down with what Seefeld terms a "doozy of a trip," to the Lincoln, Liberty and LaPayette peaks area of the White Mountains in New Hampshire.

The "doozy" is only for very experienced hikers, Seefeld said.

Since Seefeld has taken on the program directorship at the Y, he has become known as "Digger."

"If any of these trips interest you," he said, "call the Y and ask for Digger."

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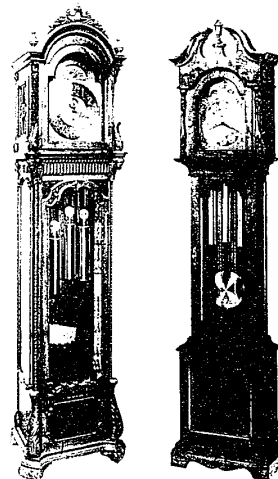
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
