These measures could help erode the festival's debt.

But rather than appearing to bound merchants and residents to pay for a shrunken festival, the committee says

it wants to get the festival back on the right financial track.

"I want it to be the way it used to be," said Mrs. Huff, a veteran of festival organization in Farmington.

"I want it to be self-supporting. We've got to get this back on a break even basis per year," she said.

For without financial aid, the Farmington Founders' Festival could go the way of cross country car vacations.
