

## Pottery is shown

Henry Ford Museum's special exhibit, "Panorama of Pottery," which runs from March 29 through April 13, could easily be subtitled, "A program with visitor participation offering everything you always wanted to know about pottery but didn't know who to ask."

The program, new this year, will be offered 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. weekdays and 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekends and Good Friday. The exhibit will begin with a potter making reproductions from the Henry Ford Museum collections. There will also be demonstrations of decorating redware and craftsmen showing methods of slush casting, drupe molding and examples of waxing, glazing and decorating a candlestick.

Slush casting is a method by which the clay mixture, or slush, is poured inside a hinged mold. Some of the material adheres to the inside of the mold while the rest is poured out. As the slush hardens, the mold is pulled away. In drupe molding, the clay is draped over a mold, left to harden, then removed and the piece is finished.

"PANORAMA OF POTTERY" also provides a hands-on experience for visitors. Six potter's wheels, using kick-power, are available with clay samples for visitors to try their hands at making a small bowl — or whatever else it develops into.

Another hands-on segment will allow visitors to work with the various methods of decorating pottery, including slip trailing and sprigging. In addition, there will be demonstrations of decorating stoneware.

There will be six cases of redware selected from the museum's collections. Also there will be an exhibit of the various clays used to make redware and a slide presentation on the preparation of the clay for the potter's wheel.

Another display, using cut-away illustrations, will show the steps necessary to make a candleholder, an inkwell, a grease lamp and a small bottle.

There is no additional charge for "Panorama of Pottery," beyond regular museum admission of \$4.25 for adults, \$2.25 for children 6-12 or the special senior citizen rate of \$3.50. Children under six are admitted free of charge.

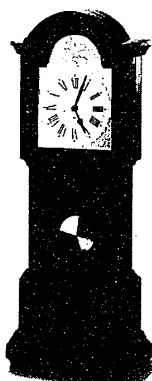
## Cat crypt
