THE FUNDAMENTALS aren't as awesome as they might sound. Her basics include building an identity through art, not being afraid to ex-press oneself and intellectualizing

So, the stress will be on develop-ing awareness in several areas — of

art as a part of history, of color and form, and primarily of self.

During the eight weeks, Mrs. Harbeck will introduce her students to the value of economy — that it's not necessary to have elaborate equipment to do a pleasing painting, that one sheet of drawing, paper can serve many purposes and that a lot can be done through an understanding of positive and negative space and the interaction of one line and one color tone with another.

THE STUDENTS in "Think Green" are very likely to come away with the beginning of an un-derstanding of the influence of the Bauhaus and the art of pre-war Ger-many. Mrs. Harbeck also plans to show slides illustrating how master painters used monochromatics in their work.
