Some West Bloomfield singles prospects include juniors Brad Stevens, Dave Berne and Jeff Greenberg. Senior Scott VanDorn and juniors Mike Brown and Todd Denenberg are doubles players.

"The one spot that's really up for grabs is No. 3 doubles," Kopec said. "A lot of kids are fighting for that position."  
 West Bloomfield begins its season on April 23 at home against Birmingham Brother Rice.

At Farmington High, coach Richard Burgess has "some bright spots and some dark spots." Last year, Farmington finished third in the Inter Lakes League behind champion Livonia Stevenson and Walled Lake Central.

**JUNIOR BILL** Knauer was last year's No. 1 singles player. Some other experienced players are seniors John Kerr, Bernard Bunyak and Jim Boston, and juniors Jim Diroff and Chip Waack.

 available at the 2 p.m. awards ceremony in the high school cafeteria. There is a five-hour time limit for completing the race.

Douglas Kurtis of Livonia turned in the fastest time — 2:32:07 — last year on the Belle Isle course. He also won the men's open division Loren Richway of Toledo, Ohio, took top honors among the women competitors with a time of 3:34:28.

Some 194 runners registered for the 1979 West Bloomfield Marathon. Contestants came from 50 Michigan communities ranging from the township itself to Port Huron and Holland. Runners also came from five cities in Ohio and three in Ontario.

Interested citizens, some representing high school track and cross country teams, have volunteered to help out with the race. "We're counting on having about 100 volunteers to direct runners along the route, to man aid stations (water and Gatorade) every three miles, and to provide split times at the one, five, 10, 15, 20 and 25 mile marks," Proulx said.

# Live wires triumph

Oakland Live Y'er swimmers grabbed nine places during the state AA AAU girls' swimming championships March 28-30 at Royal Oak Kimball High School. Top swimmers from 43 AAU teams competed in the meet.

Amy Proctor, swimming in the 10 and under division, recorded the best finish for the Live Y'ers, placing fourth in the 50-yard backstroke (34.3). Lynn Jaworski was eighth in the same event (36.5).

Paula Cassoni had her best times in five of her seven events and she placed in the top 12 in four of them. Cassoni, competing in the 13-14 group, had three seventh — in the 400-yard individual medley (4:53.1), the 200-yard individual medley (2:16.79) and the 100-yard butterfly (1:03.52). She was also 10th in the 300-yard backstroke (2:25.43).

Other top-12 placers for the Live Y'ers included Liz Cooper, 10th in the 11-12 100-yard breast; Missy Proctor, eighth in the 15-18 100-yard back (1:04.78); and Leri McAfee, 10th in the 15-18 200-yard back (2:30.31).

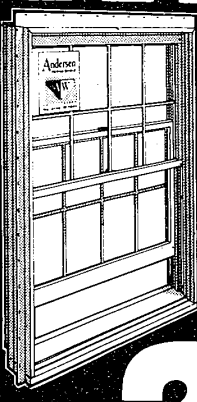
