

Barnard Hughes starring in 'Da'

"Da," Hugh Leonard's Irish comedy that won 16 awards on Broadway, continues through April 13 at the Music Hall in Detroit. Barnard Hughes, who was the original "Da" in New York, will re-create his starring role in Detroit.

Four major awards as "Best Play" were accorded "Da," including the 1977 Tony, the N.Y. Drama Critics' Circle, the Drama Desk and the Outer Critics' Circle Prize. Barnard Hughes collected three awards as "Best Actor," including the coveted Tony.

"Da" (Irish slang for "Dad") is an autobiographical play, based largely on episodes in the life of playwright Hugh Leonard. The action takes place in the course of one day, when after his father's death, a son returns home to Dublin to sort out the family papers.

He finds himself surrounded by heckling family ghosts, including that of himself as a young man and, of course, his curmudgeon of a father, "Da."

The first Irish playwright to receive a Tony Award, Leonard has written more than 20 stage plays, all of which have been produced.

Previously, American audiences have known him for "The Au Pair

Man," presented at Lincoln Center starring Julie Harris and Charles Durning. In reviewing "Da," the N.Y. Post's Clive Barnes wrote, "This is a play that has charm and love, warmth and humor. Wonderful, witty, wise and once again witty."

In the Detroit cast, Hughes will be joined by his wife, actress Helen Stenborg, and their daughter Laura Hughes, who is making her professional debut in this production.

Performances of "Da" are at 8:30 p.m. Tuesday-Saturday, 6:30 p.m. Sunday, and 2 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. Tickets can be purchased at the Music Hall box office, 350 Madison, or by calling 965-7680 and using a VISA or Master Charge card. Box office hours are 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday-Saturday.
