Live with energy alternatives

An energy workshop on solar and wind power next week stresses that "we can live with energy alternatives—today."

It is sponsored Saturday, April 19 by the Upland Hills Ecological Awareness Center, 2575 Indian Lake Road, Oxford.

Phillip Moore, environmental educator and associate director of the center, says the all-day workshop is aimed at homeowners and persons who want a basic understanding of energy alternatives.

Presentations will be made by Moore and by Richard MacMath and Wayne Appleyard, architects from Sunstructures, Inc.

Fee is \$30 for members, \$35 for non-members. To enroll or ask questions, call the Upland Hills center at 693-1021.

WATERFORD OAKS County Park west of Pontiac will be drawing handicapped persons of all ages for a "super Saturday" of games and activities April 12.

From 1-4 p.m., mentally and physically impaired persons can roller skate, play tennis, platform tennis, horseshoes and shuffleboard at the new tennis complex.

YOUR 1979 fishing license is good until April 21. The Michigan Legislature has been unable to agree on a new set of hunting and fishing license fees, so the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) has extended the life of the old licenses. It had previously been extended to March 31.

The 1980 licenses cannot be distributed to dealers until the fees are set. It's virtually certain they will go up, probably about 40 percent over two years.

"Tax limitation" doesn't apply to fees.

THREE NATURE programs are coming up at nearby Huron-Clinton Metroparks:

At 7 p.m. Saturday, April 12, Stony Creek naturalist Roger Bajorek will show slides on owls, "the mighty mouse hunters," and lead a prowl around the woods near the nature center. Register in advance by calling the nature center at 781-4621.

At 1 p.m. Sunday, April 12, Kensington naturalist Bob Healing will lead "A Spring Walk at Spring Hill." The two-hour walk starts at the nature center building. Bring binoculars. Register in advance by calling 685-1581.

At 7 p.m. Wednesday, April 16, Kensington naturalist Dave Mullen will lead a two-hour walk to look at "Nature's Night Life." Bring flashlights, wear boots and call in advance to register.

Programs are free, but there is a vehicle admission charge of \$2 a visit or \$7 for a season pass.
