# Thanks to lasers, we can 'hear' Bell's shadow

100 y phone had to wait for the invention of laser, ultra-transparent glass fibers and much of modern electronics to be come practical.

LIGHTWAVE communications helped report events of the Winter Olympies at Lake Placid, N.V., relaying the sounds, color television pictures, and sports statistics to the world. Heart of a typical lightwave system is half-inch cable of up to 144 strands of threadiling lass filters that can convey almost 50,000 separate communications.

The photophone was already a germ in Bell's mind when he talked to members of the Royal Society in London on May 17, 1878, about a newly discovered property of the element selenium. "If you insert selenium in the telephone battery and throw light upon it, you change its resistance and vary the strength of the current you have sent to the telephone, so that you can hear a shadow."

HIS LIPS close to the photophone mouthplece, Bell would begin with "Hoy! hoy!," which he insisted was the best way to open calls.



ments, on Feb. 19 and on March 30 and April 1, they packed the equipment in two sealed tin boxes with descriptions of the tests, certified by eyewitnesses. The equipment from the February experiment is the centerpiece of an exhibit, The 100th Anniversary of the Photophone, at National Geographic Society beadquarters in Washington, D.C. The exhibit, put together by Bell Laboratories, beadquartered at Murray Hill, N.J., also includes lightwave communications.
