

Orchard Ridge launches enrichment program

Once again, the Orchard Ridge campus of Oakland Community College is offering its short courses for the academically talented from kindergarten through 12th grade.

Registration will be on April 12, from 10 a.m. to noon at the registration desk, M building. The campus is located between Orchard Lake and Farmington roads, south of 12 Mile in Farmington Hills.

Tuition is payable only by check or money order to Oakland Community College.

The classes will meet for six weeks, April 26 through June 7. The only ex-

ception is the dog obedience class which will meet for 12 sessions, from April 20 to July 19.

Following is a list of courses, cost and suggested registration:

- **Animation** — Course involves learning about the persistence of vision and how it can be applied to drawings that seem to move. Cost is \$24. Suggested for grades three-eight.
- **How did it get built and why didn't it fall down?** — An experience in listening, participating and enjoying the fundamentals of architecture. Cost is \$24 plus materials fee. Suggested for grades five-seven.

- **Basic dog obedience** — A 12-week course designed to teach the basic obedience commands and exercises necessary to produce a happy well-behaved dog.
- **A health certificate** indicating date of all inoculations, condition of skin, and fecal examination is required by the first class. All dogs must be at least six months old. Students should be accompanied by parents.
- **Cost is \$39 plus a \$10 material fee.** Suggested for grades six through 12.

- **CARTOONING** — Involves learning to cartoon a face, body proportion and stances, caricature and drawing simple cartoons. Cost is \$24. For grades three-eight.
- **Clowning, mime and theater** — Learn makeup, juggling, performing

and non-competitive games. Students will write and perform their own skits as well as learn about theater techniques. Cost is \$24. For grades five-nine.

- **Computer programming** — Various computer programming languages such as Fortran and Basic will be taught. Two sections: grades six-nine and 10-12. Cost is \$24 plus a \$10 lab fee payable at registration.
- **Continental cuisine** — Students will learn basics of continental cuisine through preparation of lunch each week. Cost is \$30 plus a \$10 lab fee. Suggested for grades nine through 12.
- **Current issues in sports** — Issues to be discussed include politics and the Olympics, baseball free agency, pay TV and sports, instant replay, sports reporters and broadcasters, violence,

winning amateurs and pros, college recruiting violations and officiating.

Cost is \$18. Suggested for grades nine through 12.

- **An introduction to filmmaking** — An introduction to filmmaking by means of discussion, screening of films and practical experience, will acquaint students with the basic filmmaking concepts.

Students will have the opportunity to plan and produce a short Super 8mm sound movie. Two sections: grades five-eight and nine through 12. Cost is \$24 plus a \$7 lab fee payable at time of registration.

- **LEARNING FRENCH** using oral methods — Course I is introduction to French through oral method of songs, fairy tales and stories. Cost is \$21. Suggested for grades four-seven.

- **Learning French** using oral methods — Course II for those who have had the first portion or for students who have a knowledge of French basics. Cost is \$21 for grades four-seven.

- **Pantomime as theater**, the art of pantomime — Workshop will review earlier themes and techniques and will emphasize performing as a group, culminating in a student production. Cost is \$24 for grades 10-12.

- **Pantomime as theater**, the craft of pantomime — Workshop will cover basics of visual, non-verbal communications as a creative and expressive performing art. Styles of movement will include illusion, characterization, Tia Chi, mask work. Cost is \$24 for grades 10-12.
