Annual visits to China bring authentic touch to cuisine classes

The Imperial Palace or the Great Wall of China hardly get a glance from Ina Tehen on her annual visits to the Orient.

The Farmington Hills resident heads straight for the kitchens of the finest restaurants in China to watch, sample and discuss the subfleties of Chinese cuisine with the country's leading chefs who specialize in all styles of Chinese food.

Her know-how is brought back into classes in Farmington Community Center where students get acquainted with more than 20 dishes from various regions of China in each four-week course. This is done through demonstration, then sampling the excellence of authentic bors d'oeuvres, main courses and desserts.

Her class for beginners this season runs from 12:30 to 3 p.m. or 7:30-10 p.m. on Tuesdays beginning April 15.

Mrs. Tchen is one of Detroit metro-politan area's most respected authori-ties on authentic Chinese cooking. Her yearly tours include visits to Hong Kong, the Republic of China and the People's Republic of China in search of new recipes to share.

Her philosophy is based on present-ing a comprehensive sequence in Chi-nese cuisine emphasizing the profes-sional techniques that cannot be learned from a cookbook.

MRS. TCHEN has been teaching in the center since 1974 and has had, at times, long waiting lists of students.

She also instructs private gourmet classes on how to prepare the most elaborate of banquet dishes.

Her expertise is sought after by area cooking experts and she has served as the Chinese representative for many benefit dinners organized by Detroit's leading chefs.

Recipes students get in her classes in the center are the same ones used by the Chinese cooks in their own homes.

"I'm proud of our cuisine and want to show the ingenuity of food prepara-tion our cooks are famous for all over the world," she says.


Most of her students, she adds, continue on with her second series of classes, which begin this spring in the center on May 13.


