including a new four-acre Victorian Garden and a 19th century conservato-

Speaker to spell out Gesell method of child development

Stephanie Riley, a member of National Lecture Staff, Gesell Institute of Child Development, will speak at 8 p.m. Tuesday, April 15, in Nardin Park United Methodist Church, 11 Mile and Middlebelt roads. As the guest of Nardin Park Community Nursery School, she will speak on "Tools Your Child Needs for a Successful Year in Kindervarten."

The Gesell Institute has been work-ing with children for about 60 years. The principles discovered and defined by the institute have been used by edu-cators, pediatricians and psychologists to determine a child's rate and stage of growth.

to determine a child's rate and stage of growth.

The institute emphasizes the importance of developmental readiness for primary school entrance, neither by chronological age or IQ.

"Since children develop at different rates, it is the developmental level which determines a child's ability to perform the work at any given grade level," said Mada Briggs, director of the nursery.

e nursery. "Developmental evaluation and

placement can reduce learning disabil-ities and promote positive school experiences," she continues.
"The institute research has shown that at age 5, possibly 50 percent of av-erage normal children are not ready for the usual reading program and do not as yet have the cognitive skills for formal learning."

MRS. BRIGGS said it was her hope that the free program, given by the nursery school as a community service, would help all parents understand developmental readiness.

"Since many schools in the area have introduced the Gesell developmental placement method in their systems, the presentation should enhance unstanding of the theory." She said.
