"Justine."

"Mad Love" and "Justine" both appear on The Cretones" "This Red Line" album. It is not only the writing that makes the songs, it's the voice.

Ms. Ronstaid gives Goldenberg's songs more power then even be gives been. Old keyboard player Andrew Gold helps out with background vocals for "Justine".

The album contains two dynamic singles, "How Do I Make You? and "I Can't Let Go." Every song on the album is capable of radio air play and each one should be a hit.
