Michael Moriarty will open a tour of the award-winning hit play "Whose Life Is It Anyway?" May 20 to June 15 at the Birmingham Theatre.

Detroit-born Moriarty has received two Emmy Awards, one for his explosive portrayal of SS officer Dorf in the highly acclaimed "Holocaust" and the

other for his role as the gentleman caller in "The Glass Menagerie."

He also holds a Tony Award for his performance in "Find Your Way Home."

Authoried by Brian Cline, "Whose Life" was proclaimed Best Play of 1978 in London and, subsequently, nomi-

nated for five Tony Awards. Clark recently re-wrote his script for a female lead, Mary Tyler Moore.

"WHOSE LIFE" is currently enjoying its second successful Broadway run.

Previews of "Whose Life" will begin May 15 and conclude May 18. Evening performances will begin at 8 p.m. There also is a matinee performance at 2 p.m. May 18.

Coming season shows announced
