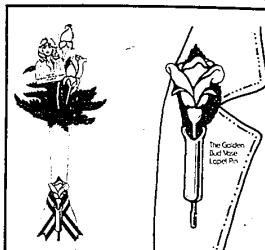
Sierra Club meeting features conservation and conversation
