A sophomore freestyler, Segrue helped Bowling Green compile its best dual-meet record (9-4) in if years dur-ing the 1979-80 season. The feam estab-lished 13 records, 11 coming in the Mid-American Conference champion-ships in which Bowling Green placed fifth.

Three of those records belong at least in part to Segrue. He set one record in the 500-yard freestyle with a time of 4:44.30, good for sixth place in the MAC meet.
