

Lakers open league with win

Sandy DeSilvio singled in the winning run in the bottom of the fifth and Deanna Asbury secured it with a bases-loaded triple in the sixth as West Bloomfield's softball squad topped Clarkston 6-1 Monday.

The victory was the fifth straight without a loss for the Lakers and their first in the Greater Oakland Athletic League (GOAL).

Lynn Gerber and Clarkston's Kelly Mason were locked in a scoreless pitchers' duel through the first four innings. But Clarkston broke through with a run in the top half of the fifth to take a 1-0 lead.

West Bloomfield came right back in the bottom half of the inning, as Lisa Schmidt walked and came all the way home on Carlyn Barzewicz' base hit. Barzewicz took second on the throw to the plate and scored the gamewinner on DeSilvio's single.

Asbury capped it with her slam in the sixth.

Gerber went the distance to pick up the win. She allowed five hits and four walks while striking out three. Mason was the loser.
