# Pontiac Central takes invitational

Pontiac Central, behind two first-place finishes by Delores Bennett, grabbed top honors in the West Bloomfield Invitational girls track meet Saturday at West Bloomfield High.

Bennett's wins were both meet records. She won the discus with a throw of 113-5 and the shot put with a heave of 42-8. The record in the shot was the result of a heavier weight being used in girls' competition this year.

Central also finished being used four times and had a fourth and a sixth in the 28-team meet. Livonia Stevenson was second with 47 points, followed by Brighton and Rochester in a tie for

third (34), Pontiac Northern in fifth (33) and Royal Oak Dondoro in sixth (26).

Other local team finishes were, Bloomfield Hills Adverser, tied with Walled Lake Western for ninth (20), host-team West Bloomfield, 11th (17), Livonia Ladywood, 13th (12), Redford Bishop Borge, 16th (9), Walled Lake Central, 17th (8), Farmington Our Lady of Mercy and Redford Union, tied for 19th (8), and Bloomfield Hills Lahser, in a five-way tie for 22nd (2).

Adverser's Kori Gifford was a double winner in individual events and established new meet records in winning the 100-yard dash (11.0) and the long jump (18-1/4).

WESTERN'S JUDY YUHN was

named the meet's outstanding performer. Yuhn won the two-mile run (11:45.4) and anchored Western's winning sprint medley relay team (4:21.8) with a 2:0.0 split in the half mile. Yuhn finished the meet by turning in a 2:23.0 half-mile split in Western's two-mile relay, which failed to place.

Other individual winners were Pontiac Northern's Jane Hardy in the high jump (5-4), Amy Thomas of Dearborn in the mile run (6:13.4) and Monique Ozimkowski of West Bloomfield in the 100-yard low hurdles (14.7).

Brighton won a pair of relays, with Jenn Lacour, Ginny Patrick, Pat Hampton and Sue Brown grabbing top honors in the two-mile event (1:06.2). Brighton also won the shuttle hurdles relay (1:06.2).

Flint Beecher's team of Sandra Harris, Sabrina Young, Diane Wiley and Lajewell Gaston won the 880-yard relay (1:47.3) and tied for first in the 440-yard relay with Northern's Sandra Spears, Pamela Armstrong, Lori Reaver and Rita Robinson (59.8).

Rochester's mile relay team got an outstanding effort from anchorperson Gretchen Baker to nip Central's four-some for the victory. Both finished in 4:11.3. Joining Baker were Aimee Landry, Michelle Dembrowski and Erika Bauer.

Livonia Stevenson's second-place team finish was greatly aided by five finishes among the top six in the six relay events. The Spartans also had three individual second places: Kathy Finn in the long jump (17-6-1/2), Katy Donovan in the discus (107-9), and Lori Bennett in the mile run (5:21.0).
