
## Provide outlet for sibling rivalry

Tape the paper strips over the top of the shoe box so that an inch of paper overlaps on each side of the box. Secure with tape being sure the strips do not sag in the middle. Place one paper clip on top of each strip of paper at one end. By placing the popsicle magnet under the paper strip, the paper clip can be guided along the strip to the other end of the shoe box. With a little practice, speed will improve.


