Dorati announces new concert series

Detroit Symphony Music Director Antal Dorati has announced the 1980-81 subscription concert series at Ford

81 subscription concert series at Ford Auditorium.
This will mark the Detroit Symphony Orchestra's 67th concert season. In addition to the major subscription events, highlights of the season include a Bartok Pestival celebrating the 100th anniversary of the composer's birth; a gala 75th birthday celebration for Mæstro Dorati with two performances of Benevier's "Fidelich" the annual Holiday Festival and a Joffrey Ballet Dance Festival.

Dorati will honor three American composers celebrating milestone birth-days in 1980 — Aaron Coplan, 80, Sam-uel Barber, 70, and William Schuman,

Dorati will conduct 27 of the subscription concerts. He is scheduled to be on the podium at Ford Auditorium for a total of 12 weeks. The 1980-81 season marks Dorati's fourth as the orange of the control of the c chestra's music director. On April 9, 1981 he will celebrate his 75th birth-
