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Energy survey underway

A survey on energy usage of residents of Oakland and Livingston counties is underway by the Oakland-Livingston Human Service Agency and Michigan State University.

A random sample of 250 residents has been made. Thirty OLHSA staff and volunteers, identifiable by OLHSA employee badges, are conducting the hour-long interviews.

Results of the month-long survey will be shared with many community groups, planning entities and state legislators. According to Steve Ward, OLHSA statistical analyst, the data will help "those groups understand the energy situation and give them a better focus while planning solutions to those identified energy problems."

All questions relate to home energy use and include such questions as: How much insulation do you have in your at-

tic? What is your primary heating source? What is the temperature in your dwelling kept?

There are also several questions about attitudes towards the energy situation and what residents have done to conserve energy.

Project directors from MSU include: Dr. Garland A. Wood, department of agricultural economics; Dr. Lawrence M. Sommers, department of geography and center for environmental quality; and James H. Johnson, department of geography.

In addition to Ward, OLHSA staff on the project are: Doris B. Storer, division manager, data evaluation program; Claudine Merritt, division manager, community development and Steve Facione, department head, project operations.
