In two events at the Class B regional. He placed second in the 400-meter dash (51.4) and landed third in the 200-meter dash (23.4).

Teammate Steve Shamborn qualified in the high jump by going 6 feet to place third at the regional.

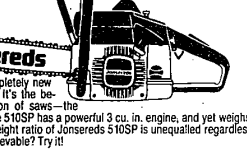
Birmingham Brother Rice won the Farmington regional with 83 points. Birmingham Seaboard was second with 53½ points, and Brighton had 51½.

Rice's Jim Browne won three individual events. He established a field and regional record in the discus with a toss of 175-1, and then won the shot put (56-11) and the 120-yard high hurdles (15.3).

Ypsilanti Lincoln won the Clarenceville meet with 67 points. Saline placed second with 69½, and Dexter landed third with 64. Harrison placed sixth with 30 points.

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
