White has managed to hit one of black's checkers in the bear-off after black removed two checkers. Black then got lucky and was able to get his checker off the bar and around white's four-point prime with one roll. White now rolls a six-two. What does white do?

The timid player sees an opportunity o make a safe point and runs up with oth men to take black's 11 point. Absorbable perfect


