A single taxpayer's next dollar after a taxable income of \$34,100 is taxed at 49 percent. Comparable taxable in-

come in the 49-percent bracket for fil-ing married joint and married separate starts at \$45,800 and \$22,900, respec-tively.

The way inflation is going and in-comes keep rising, it is becoming easi-er to get into the high tax brackets. Tax considerations in investments become more important.

Some people invest in stocks, others tax free bonds. Still others, like Goldberg and his syndicate, look to sports. Goldberg said that the average thoroughbred trained to race runs 16-20 times per year.

OWNERS GENERALLY are paid 60 percent of the purse for finishing first in a race, 20 percent for second and 10 percent for third, according to George Maskin, publicist at DRC.
