Research Chemist Will Turn To Teaching In Bible College

When he's ready to retire, William Ely has decided he'd rather look back on a career of helping young people than one concerned only with business. So the tall, church worker, who's a time away from retirement, is coming up his post as research chemist at Packard-Davis to become head of the science department at Great Lakes Bible College.

Ely, who taught for three years at Carmichael-Melton High School, before joining Packard-Davis, said he gets his greatest satisfaction from teaching "under the right circumstances."

To him, that means "the attitude and atmosphere of a Bible college."

"The kids at such schools have respect for authority and respect for each other, and sometimes you don't find that at larger schools," he said.

"At Great Lakes, the faculty is small but devoted to work, and the school is rapidly becoming very highly rated academically."

Ely said the school is looking to acquire more property and expand its facilities to offer a full junior college program.

"That will mean broadening of the science department to include chemistry and other sciences," Ely said. For now, his department includes general science and biology.

Ely has taught part time at the college previously and been on its curriculum study committee.

Joan Ely also plans to work at the college, possibly as a librarian this year. She might later transfer to bookkeeping work.

LIFE FOR the family probably won't change greatly, since both parents figure they'll soon take up active membership in one of the four Church of Christ congregations in the Lansing area.
