

Youths angle for prizes

Three new and special prizes are awaiting young anglers in the June 14 Tom Sawyer-Becky Thatcher fishing derby at Newburgh Lake.

The youngsters who catch the largest bluegill, sunfish and largemouth bass will win trips for themselves and a parent on a Lake St. Clair charter boat.

"The prize was donated by Capt. Tony Jaros of Detroit," said Hank Chrushal, contest chairman for the Western Wayne County Conservation Association.

"He goes for trophy muskies. He catches a little more than some of the others, but he's the best around," said Chrushal.

The THREE winners and three parents will take their muskie cruise the morning of Sunday, July 6 on a 29-foot cruiser.

All tackle will be furnished by Capt. Jaros, who departs from the Jefferson Beach marina. They will be aboard a 29-foot cabin cruiser and will be the only party on board.

The Newburgh Lake contest on June 14 runs from 7 a.m. until noon. It's open to boys and girls ages 6-16, inclusive. They must register at the registration table on Newburgh Point, which is visible from Edward Hines Drive west of Newburgh Road.

State fish laws must be strictly observed, Chrushal said. The legal size limit for northern pike is 26 inches and

for bass 12 inches. Any angler keeping a smaller pike or bass will have all his or her entries disqualified.

In another rule change, anglers will no longer be limited to live bait. They may use such artificial lures as flies, poppers, plugs, spinners, spoons, jigs and plastic crawlers if they wish.

GRAND PRIZE for the largest fish will be an Old Pal, five-drawer tackle box full of lures, a fishing rod, reel and hand net donated by Livonia Tackle Supply.

The grand prize winner will also receive an inscribed plaque, which will be made and donated by the Sarver Center Boys Club of Redford Township. The largest bluehead will be worth a propane lantern donated by L&L Hardware of Westland.

First prize for rock bass is a tackle box full of lures and a wire mesh net from Sportsman's Village, Canton Township.

For the largest crappie, the angler will receive a deluxe backpack from Gell's Sporting Goods, Livonia.

Whoever lands the largest northern pike will win a two-person raft, pump and pair of life preservers from the conservation club.

The club will also award a sleeping bag for the largest golden carp (goldfish).

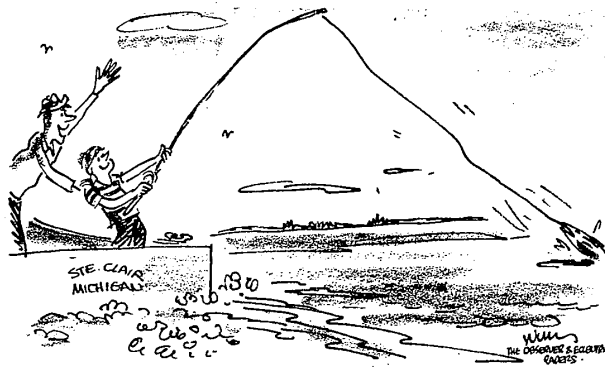
For the largest carp, the angler will receive a grill and four-person cooking set from Campers Paradise of Livonia.

First prize for a channel catfish is a 53-quart Thermos cooler from Stan's Borton and Auto Service of Livonia.

SEVERAL YOUNG fishermen usually catch their limit of 25 panfish and roughfish. In this category, a name will be drawn, and the winner will receive a unicycle from Reliable Bicycle Shop of Livonia.

For each species of fish, there will be three to six other prizes. These will include tackle boxes, sets of lures, minnow buckets, landing nets, snorkel equipment, bike CB radios and fancy belt buckles.

The contest is co-sponsored by the Western Wayne County Conservation Association and the parks departments of Farmington, Farmington Hills, Northville, Plymouth, Livonia, Westland, Garden City and Dearborn Heights.
