"Detroit, I enjoy it a lot," said Cleminson in a telephone interview, as he was getting ready to play for a sold-out audience in Lexington, Ky.

The song is well-liked by the listening public, but what exactly is it about? "That's a good question," Cleminson said. "I don't really know. It's just a series of images and scenarios that you catch a glimpse of in rock "ir roll." Cleminson, who started playing gui-

Cleminson discussed the differences between European and American audiences and concerts.

"EUROPE HAS a much more immediate audience because of the small theater-size venues. You have more da theatrical contract with your audience. They can see more and get more involved individually.

"In America you have to use different kinds of effects to, shall we say, 'stun' the audience."

Cleminson listed persons he admires and enjoys listening to, which goes

from Frank Zappa to Stravinsky.

"I like Jeff Beek as a guitar player and as a writer. I've always liked Bob Dylan to some extent."

Cleminson even is fond of some new wave bands.
"I finish the Police are doing some great things. I like what the new wave bands. are trying to do. I was influenced very much by new wave. I was living in the middle of it in London," He said.

Since then it's matured and gotten a lit-tle more sophisticated and now it's called new wave.


