As a family, the Zamchyks drove 361

miles and used 23 gallons of gasoline. During the second week, the family drove 301 miles and used 17 gallons of

gas.
In order to reduce their gas consumption, the Zamchyks drove slower, used their smaller economy car more often and consolidated shopping trips

often and consolidated shopping trips and coasted to traffic lights.

"Farmington motorists who drive 15,000 miles annually save approximately \$140 by cutting gas use at least 15 percent," said Swift.

"That estimate is based.on no-lead gasoline selling for \$1.34 per gallon."

The Powers family was reluctant at first to join the experimentand not because they don't believe in conservation. Rather, they felt they'd aiready lake all the fuel-saving steps available two months ago when they decided to save money by curbing their energy appetite.

Debra Powers walks or hike to her job at the Magnolia Community Canter. Her husband, Eddie, drives the family care to work at Kmart headquarters in Troy daily and makes a point of tapping for groceries on his way home from work.

But, by being even more conscientious, the Powers were able to reduce their mileage by 35 percent in the second week of the program.




