## Northwest Y opens summer registration

## Red Cross needs blood

All seven Red Cross blood donor centers are extending their hours during the week of June 2-6 to accept blood donations and avert a potentially serious blood shortage in the Detroit area.

For the convenience of blood donors, regional centers will be open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m., Monday-Friday that week.

Auto company layoffs have led to the cancellation of at least two blood

drives sponsored by car manufacturers in their plants. The Red Cross estimates that both drives would have brought in 3,500 pints of blood.

Blood can be given by anyone between the ages of 17, with parental consent and 65-years-old. Donors must be in good general health. Donors older than 65 must have written permission from their personal physician.

Registration can be accomplished from 6 a.m.-11 p.m., weekdays at the Y, 28100 Farmington Road, north of 12 Mile.

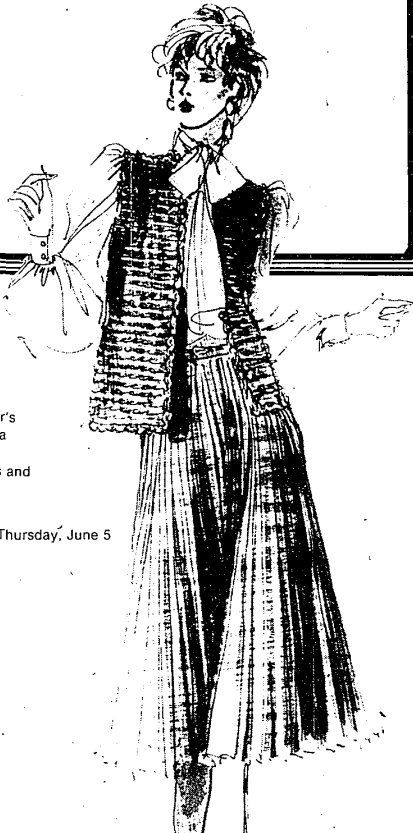

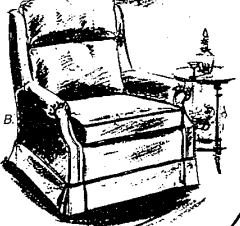

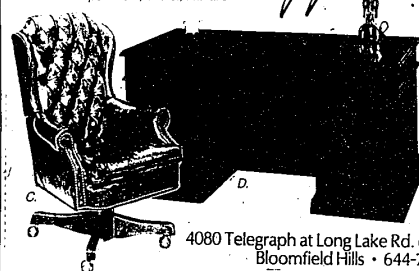
